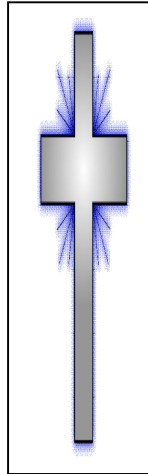

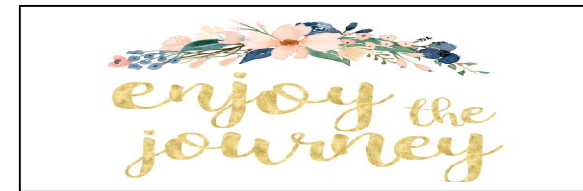

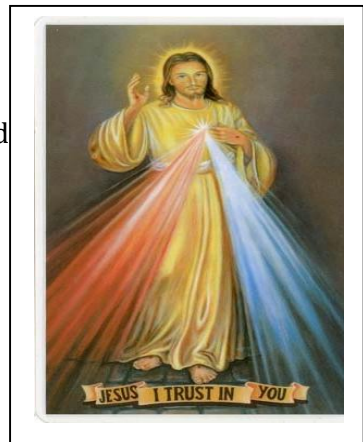

Divine Mercy Sunday April 28th, 2019

In a series of revelations to a Polish nun, St. Faustina Kowalska, in the 1930's, Our Lord called for a Feast of Divine Mercy to be celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter, so that humankind would take refuge in Him. This Feast, promoted by Saint John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000, is associated with special promises from Jesus and indulgences by the Church. As recorded in St. Faustina's diary, Jesus told her that a person who goes to sacramental confession (the confession may be a few days before) and receives holy communion on Divine Mercy Sunday shall obtain total forgiveness of all sins and punishment. In the Divine Mercy image, as revealed to St. Faustina, Jesus said "*The pale beam represents the water that cleanses and purifies souls, the red, the blood that gives new life to souls*".
