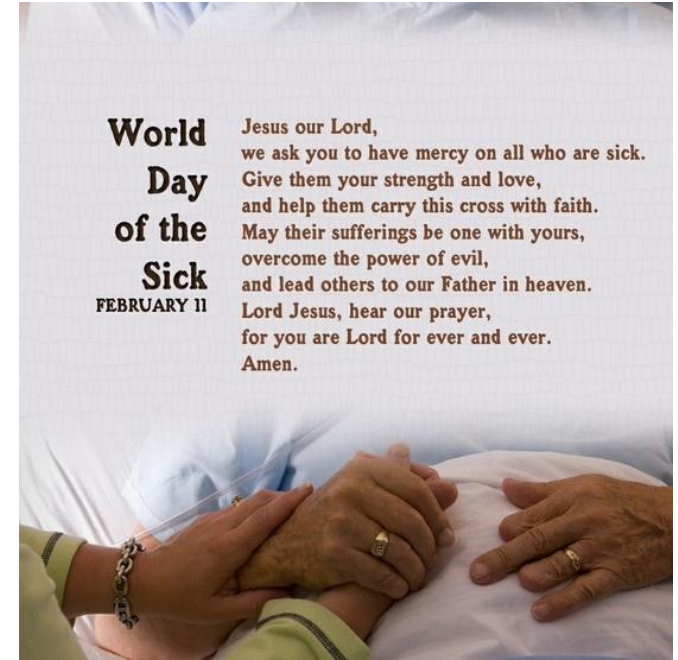

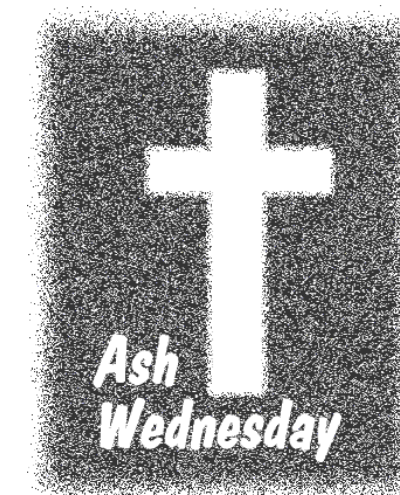


**Ash Wednesday is a day of Fast & Abstinence**
