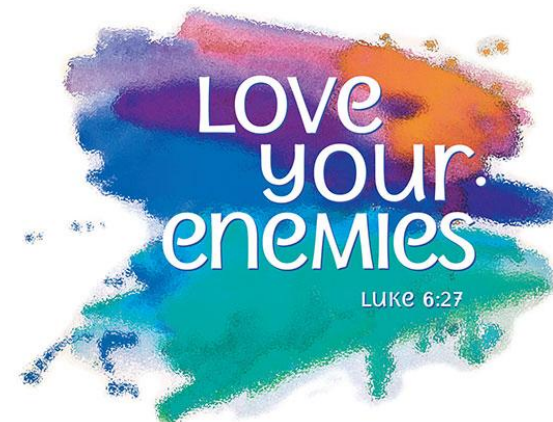

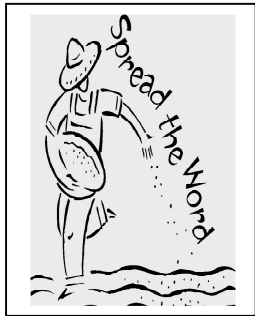
Reflection

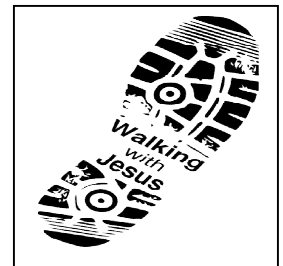
